The Waseca Band Boosters is a non-profit organization that supports the band activities in Waseca Public Schools. As a parent/guardian of a marching band student, you are now a member!

A 12-person voting board meets monthly year-round to help the band directors and staff plan and coordinate the activities of the Marching Jays, the jazz bands, the junior high band, and even the beginning 5th & 6th grade bands.

Competitive Marching Band

The Waseca Marching Jays participate in **Fall Field Competitions**. They prepare a 10-minute program of music, marching, and dance that is performed on a football field. Competitions are on Saturdays in September and the first two weeks of October.

Other Types of Competitions

- Summer Parade competitions: Bands march on the street and perform a program for the judges at a particular spot on the parade route.
- Drum and Bugle Corps / Drum Corps International (DCI): Brass, drums, and color guard perform field shows.

Competitions

Saturdays

Saturday after Labor Day through 2nd Saturday in October. Each competition has a number of bands and lasts a few hours. There is an entry fee for spectators (\$10-\$15), and you are welcome to watch as many of the bands as you like.

Itineraries

Mr. Lawrence will send a schedule with bus call time, warm-up time, and estimated performance time the week of the event.

Transportation

Students are expected to ride the bus; can be checked out by parent/guardian after the show.

Food

Students are expected to bring snacks/meals and their water jugs and/or money for concession stands. Boosters will provide meals for a few all-day events.

Volunteers

We need them on show day!! Almost all jobs on show day allow you to watch the Jays perform.



Specific Competition Notes

Prairie Colors / Eastview September 7, 2024

- Usually leave early morning for the 11:00am Prairie Colors show in Eden Prairie
- Bus over to Apple Valley for Eastview evening show
- Arrive home late!
- One meal provided by the Boosters between shows

Rosemount September 14, 2024

• They will be doing a prelims/finals at their show this year, so we could be coming home early or late

Waseca Marching Classic September 21, 2024

- The "Home Show" so the Marching Jays do not compete—they do an exhibition performance
- All families are expected to volunteer
- Usually arrive at school in the morning for a clinic
- Parade is usually at noon
- Students have a break after the parade
- Field shows start at 5:00pm
- Marchers report in the evening to perform at the end of the show
- Fireworks close out the evening

Hudson, WI September 28, 2024

 New this year! Evening show, so likely leave late morning/early afternoon and arrive home late.

Festival of Bands in Sioux Falls, SD October 5, 2024

- Usually leave at 4:00am. YES, that early!!
- Marching band parade starts at 8:00am, the Jays usually step off at about 10:00am
- Field shows are across the road at Howard Wood Field (2000 W Russell St, Sioux Falls) and start about 10:00am.
- Top 10 bands perform in Finals, starting at 7:00pm.
- Two meals provided by the Boosters
- Bus arrives home VERY late: 2:30am
- Very big festival. You may wish to book a hotel and sign out your child after the competition

Youth In Music, US Bank Stadium October 12, 2024

- aka YIM or Yimmies
- THE competition the students are working toward!
- Early morning bus call / Arrive home late!
- Mr. Lawrence will send ticket information when available–adult prices are \$35+ each
- One meal provided by the Boosters
- US Bank stadium is CASHLESS

Morning Rehearsals Continue

Mr. Lawrence will communicate the specific sections for the week each Sunday with your student. But in general, the 6:50am rehearsals will continue in the gym.

Top Velocity

Generally, upperclassmen will be invited to be in Top Velocity. It is a high-intensity drill routine that highlights advanced marching skills.
